

The St. Croix County Treasurer's office has notified the City there are 661 parcels in the City where the owners have not applied to receive the Lottery and Gaming Credit on their property tax bills.

To qualify for a Lottery and Gaming Credit you must be the owner of the property and use it as your primary residence as of January 1 for the tax year that you are applying the credit to. If you are unsure if you have received the credit, the amount is listed on your tax bill.

A person who is eligible for the credit but whose property tax bill does not reflect the credit may, by January 31 following the issuance of person's property tax bill, claim the credit by filing an application with the County Treasurer's office. The Treasurer will calculate the amount of credit you should receive and either credit your tax bill, or if the taxes have been paid, refund the credit to you.

A person who is eligible for the credit (as of the certification date) but whose property tax bill does not reflect the credit, and who has missed the January 31 deadline for applying for the credit with the municipal treasurer, may file a late claim application with the Department of Revenue by October 1 following the issuance of the person's property tax bill.
